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# **Fire Pump Policy**

# Field Acceptance Tests

### Policy

A "Fire Pump Certified Technician" must conduct the "Initial Field Acceptance Tests" on all new Peerless fire pump installations to ensure full warranty coverage. Failure to provide certified field-test results will render the warranty null and void.

# **Qualifications**

A certified fire pump technician will have attended a Peerless fire pump training seminar and/or has participated in ten or more Field Acceptance Tests. The technician will be actively involved in the sales and service of Peerless Pumps. All technicians will have received a Peerless Pump certificate, indicating their attainment of a "Fire Pump Certified Technician" status. No company shall sell a fire pump set without the assistance of a "Fire Pump Certified Technician".

### Responsibilities

The responsibilities of the Technician;

- Assist, as needed, to answer any technical questions during the design stage of the project.
- Assist, as needed, in the review of the specifications.
- Lend support, as needed, to the sales effort.
- Coordinate the acceptance test with all the necessary personnel, as required, by NFPA 20 paragraph 11.2.
- Provide all of the necessary testing equipment required to conduct the initial field acceptance test.
- Conduct the acceptance test in accordance with the requirements of the "Authority Having Jurisdiction".

## Reimbursement

The seller will reimburse the Certified Technician for a sum of \$650.00 for each fire pump. The reimbursement is for one day of service, which will include all of his travel expenses. All job site expenses will be the responsibility of the seller. It will be necessary for the seller to include the cost of the acceptance test in his purchase order to Peerless Pump. The technician will be paid directly by Peerless Pump. The payment will be in the form of a commission that must be included as a line item on the order write up. It is the responsibility of the selling organization to secure the services of a "Certified Fire Pump Technician" prior to placement of the order with the factory.
